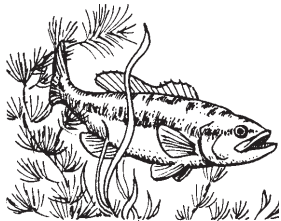

**Hickory Hills Park**  
**3338 Hickory Hills Road**  
**La Porte City**  
**Park Hours: 6 a.m. - 10:30 p.m.**

The park is located 12 miles south of Waterloo (Hwy 20) and 40 miles northwest of the Cedar Rapids metro area. Going south from Waterloo follow Highway 21 south, turn east on County Road D-52, turn south on County Road V-37 aka Dysart Road. If coming north from Cedar Rapids watch for Exit 55 towards La Porte City, follow the park signs.

Hickory Hills Park is a unique area both in terms of its natural beauty and strategic location. The park's 723 acres include one of the area's unusual geologic features: a paha. Paha is a Native American word meaning high ground. The diverse topography of the area is characteristic of a paha. Casey's Paha was dedicated as a State Preserve in 1989. Although established in Tama County in 1969, the Black Hawk County Conservation Board owns and manages the area. A Park Ranger is in residence year-round.

The park offers many leisure and recreation opportunities including camping, basketball, picnicking, sand volleyball, disc golf, hiking, fishing, cross-country skiing, sledding, and ice skating. Snowmobiles are not allowed. Several miles of hiking trails offer park users a chance to witness nature's endless variety. The 39 acre Casey Lake, nestled between scenic forested slopes, is one of Northeast Iowa's premiere largemouth bass hot spots.



**Programs**

Environmental education and outdoor recreation programs are scheduled periodically by county naturalists. All park users are welcome to attend and discover something about Hickory Hills Park. Sunset Shelter is the site for most programs. A program fee may be required.



**Wildlife Exhibit**

Numerous species representing Iowa's wildlife heritage can be observed here. Pens provide a natural setting for viewing the animals. The display usually includes bison, elk, white-tail deer, turkeys, and upland game birds.

**Campground Events**

The summer camping season is full of excitement and enjoyment for those that stay with us. Two events that add to those great experiences are the new Summer Christmas and Halloween celebrations. Both have events that will delight those of all ages. Summer Christmas will be a warm-up for the real holiday in December and will host events such as campsite decoration, contests, and activities for kids. Halloween weekend will include campsite decoration, pumpkin carving, and costume contests. Dates will be announced. **For information call Hickory Hills Park at 319-342-3350.**

**Public Hunting**

Public hunting is allowed on the west 175 acres of the park. Since the area is adjacent to and accessible only through the park, regulations prohibit the use of rifles. Other regulations and information are posted at the beginning of the access trail in the hunting area parking lot, near the west end of the lake.



**Archery Course**

A public field archery course is maintained by the Black Hawk Archers and State-wide tournaments are held here. A participation fee is charged. Dates are June 14-15; August 2-3 and September 6-7.

## Camping

The **modern camping area** consists of 82 RV sites, 27 are full hookup sites, which surrounds a large tent camping area. Tents associated with RV's are required to pitch in the tent area. Showers, laundry facilities, flush toilets, and a dump station are provided. Electricity is available at each of the RV sites, community water hydrants are scattered throughout the area. Campers need to self-register within one hour after arrival.

The **group camping area** will accommodate up to 20 RVs and/or numerous tents. Electricity is available in this area and pit toilets are provided. A shelter house is available on a first come, first served basis or may be reserved for a fee. Supervised youth groups are allowed to camp in the group camping area at a reduced rate. Adult groups are charged the same camping rate as in the modern area with a deposit.

## Cabins

Three rustic **cabins** have bunk beds, cold-water sink, microwave, table and chairs, refrigerator, a hotplate and are air conditioned. One is handicapped accessible.



Four **all-season cabins** are larger and handicapped accessible. They accommodate up to six people with two bedrooms, one with a double bed, one with bunk beds, a couch and TV/DVD in the living room, a bathroom with a shower, a kitchen with a gas range, a microwave, sink and refrigerator. They include hot water, heating and air conditioning. Three overlook Casey Lake and one is in the campground.

## Picnicking & Shelters

Several picnic facilities including tables, fire receptacles, toilets, and water are provided. Ground fires are restricted to the fire rings. In the picnic area you will find courts for sand volleyball, basketball, and a disc golf course. Shelters can be reserved for a fee or may be used on a first come, first served basis. The Archers Shelter accommodates 100, but can be expanded to serve 175. It has a dry kitchen with 2 refrigerators and 2 microwaves. The Hickory Shelter is a large, rustic, double-sided shelter accommodating 75 to 100 people on each side. The Group Camp Shelter accommodates 75. The Sunset Shelter accommodates 50 people. Keg beer is allowed only at a shelter with a paid reservation and deposit. **Reservations may be made at the main office by calling 319-266-6813.** Park users are asked to carry-in and carry-out their garbage.

## Lakeview Lodge

Overlooking Casey Lake, this four season lodge is heated, air conditioned and features a deck facing the lake. It has a kitchen and modern restrooms, making it a perfect place for weddings and reunions. It will accommodate 125 people. For further information and the cost, please call the main office at 319-266-6813.

## Casey Lake

Casey Lake is managed for largemouth bass, channel catfish, and bluegill. Crappies are found in the lake as well. A number of small ponds provide quiet fishing away from the lake. All state laws apply. Boat motor use is restricted to electric only.

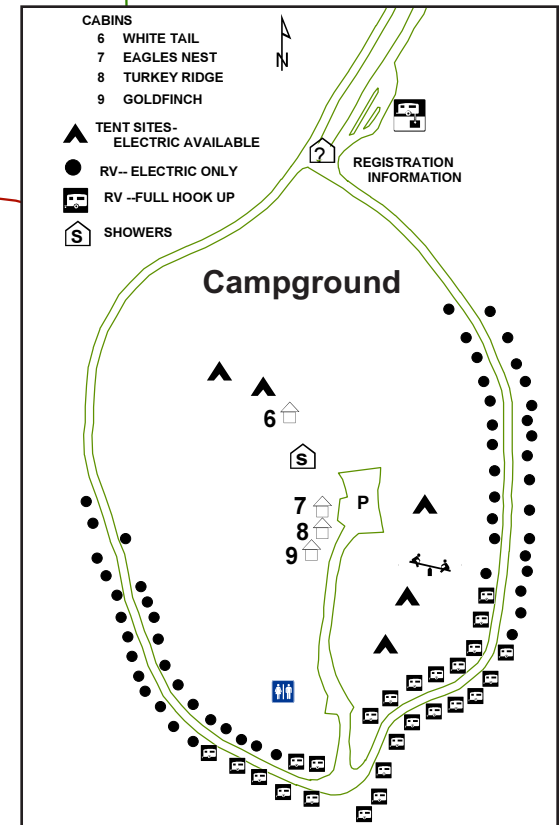
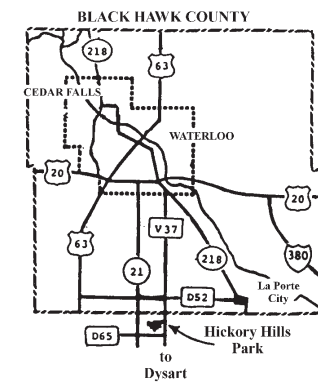
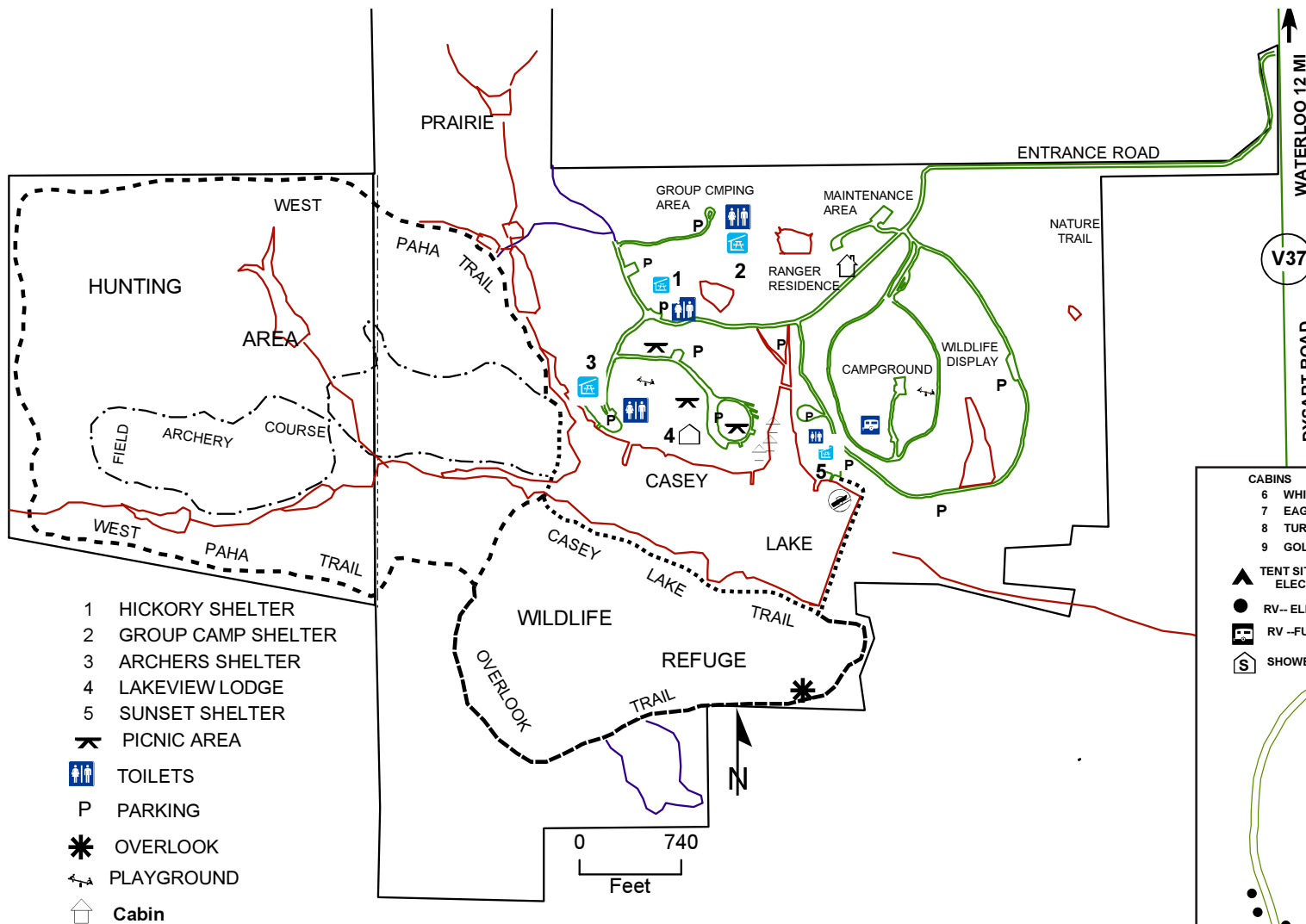
