

ORDINANCE NO. 105

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 85, AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE POLICY AND LEVEL OF SERVICE IN RESPECT TO CLEARANCE OF SNOW OR ICE AND MAINTENANCE OF THIS COUNTY’S SECONDARY ROADS DURING THE WINTER MONTHS

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, State of Iowa, as follows:

That Ordinance #85 entitled AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE POLICY AND LEVEL OF SERVICE IN RESPECT TO CLEARANCE OF SNOW OR ICE AND MAINTENANCE OF THIS COUNTY’S SECONDARY ROADS DURING THE WINTER MONTHS be amended as follows:

Section 3 – SEQUENCE OF SERVICE

DELETE the following:

MAILBOX REPLACEMENT

The County will assume no liability for mailboxes and fences damaged because of snow removal unless such action can be determined to be malicious. The County will not replace mailboxes damaged or knocked down by the force of snow thrown from the plow.

ADD the following:

DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

The County will repair or replace a mailbox or fence knocked down by the snow plow itself. A replacement mailbox will be a basic standard mailbox and post.

The County will not replace mailboxes or fences damaged or knocked down by the force of snow thrown from the plow.
