

ORDINANCE NO. 107

Title: An ordinance readopting the existing County Code, Black Hawk County, Iowa:

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. Code of Iowa §331.302(9), requires that once every five years a County shall compile its Code of Ordinances. This Ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect in Black Hawk County, Iowa.

SECTION 2. Readoption of Current Code. The following ordinances have been previously adopted and enacted into law and were duly published as the law provides. They are stated herein by number and subject matter and by the authority of the Black Hawk County Board of Supervisors comprise the Black Hawk County Code of Ordinances:

SECTION 3. Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in force on the effective date of this ordinance and not contained in the Code of Ordinances of Black Hawk County, Iowa are repealed from and after the effective date of this ordinance, except as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 4. Repeal Effect. That the repeal provided for in the preceding section of this Ordinance shall not affect any offense or act committed or done or any penalty or forfeiture incurred or any contract or right established or accruing before the effective date of this ordinance; nor shall such repeal affect any ordinance or resolution promising or guaranteeing the payment of money by the County or authorizing the issuance of any bonds of said County or any evidence of said County's indebtedness or any contract or obligation assumed by said County; nor shall said repeal affect administrative ordinances or the resolutions of the Board not in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of Black Hawk County, Iowa, 2009, nor shall it affect the following ordinances specifically saved from repeal.

Nor shall it affect any right or franchise conferred by any ordinance or resolution of the Board or any person or corporation; nor shall it affect any ordinance naming, establishing, relocating and vacating any street or public way, whether temporary or permanent; nor shall it affect any ordinance levying or imposing taxes; nor shall it affect any ordinance establishing building lines, establishing and changing grades or dedicating property for public use; nor shall it affect any prosecution, suit, or other proceeding pending or any judgment rendered on or prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: Code of Ordinances. Copies of the Code as adopted herein shall be on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 6: When Effective. This Ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
