

ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BLACK HAWK COUNTY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ELECTION PRECINCTS IN ALL UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF BLACK HAWK COUNTY, IOWA, NOW KNOWN AS TITLE I ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, State of Iowa, as follows:

That Ordinance “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ELECTION PRECINCTS IN ALL UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF BLACK HAWK COUNTY, IOWA” shall be amended as follows:

**TITLE I ADMINISTRATION
CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS**

1-6-3 F. is amended by striking the present F. and replacing with the following:

Cedar Falls Ward 3 Precinct 2/Cedar Falls Township shall consist of Cedar Falls Township, which is bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of North Butler Road and Westbrook Road and proceeding east along Westbrook Road until it intersects the corporate limits of the City of Cedar Falls, then proceeding south in a counter clockwise manner along the corporate limits of the City of Cedar Falls until it intersects West Ridgeway Avenue, and then proceeding west along West Ridgeway Avenue to its intersection with University Avenue, then proceeding west on University Avenue until it intersects South Butler Road, then proceeding north along South Butler Road until it intersects North Butler Road, then proceeding north along North Butler Road to the point of origin.

In accordance with Chapter 49.6 this precinct will include Ward 3, Precinct 2 of the City of Cedar Falls, which is contiguous to Cedar Falls Township.

**TITLE I ADMINISTRATION
CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS**

1-6-3 K. is amended by striking the present K. and replacing with the following:

Poyner Precinct 1/East Waterloo Township, Poyner Precinct 1 shall commence at the intersection of North Ordway Road and East Big Rock Road and proceed west along East Big Rock Road until it intersects the eastern corporate limits of Waterloo City, thence proceeding south and easterly in a clockwise manner following the corporate limit lines of Waterloo until the line intersects with the corporate limits of Elk Run Heights, then north, east and southeasterly in a clockwise manner following the corporate limits of Elk Run Heights until the line intersects with the corporate limits of Evansdale, then proceeding first southeast and then in a clockwise manner along the corporate limits of the City of Evansdale until it intersects Gilbertville Road, then proceeding southeasterly along Gilbertville Road until it intersects Indian Creek Road, then proceeding east until Indian Creek Road intersects McStay Road, then proceeding north on McStay Road until it intersects Dubuque Road, then proceeding west on Dubuque Road until it intersects South Ordway Road, then proceeding north along South Ordway Road and its northern extension until it intersects North Ordway Road, then proceeding north along North Ordway Road to the point of origin. This precinct includes the City of Raymond.

This precinct shall also include East Waterloo Township (northern segment), which is bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the corporate limits of the City of Waterloo and East Big Rock Road and proceeding east along East Big Rock Road until it intersects the north quarter corner of Section 3, Township 89, Range 12, then proceeding due south from this point until it intersects with the City limits of the City of Waterloo, then proceeding in a counter clockwise manner following the Waterloo city limits first westerly, then northerly, then westerly, then northerly, then westerly, then northerly to the point of origin.

And, East Waterloo Township (southern segment), which is bounded by a line commencing at a point where corporate limits of the City of Waterloo meet the western boundary line of Poyner Township, Precinct 1 in Section 22, Township 89, Range 12 and then proceeding due south until this line intersects with the corporate limits of the City of Raymond, then proceed west following the corporate limits of the City of Raymond, until its corporate limits intersect with the corporate limits of the City of Elk Run Heights, then continuing westerly along the corporate limits of the City of Elk Run Heights until its corporate limits intersect with the corporate limits of the City of Evansdale, then continuing westerly along the corporate limits of the City of Evansdale until its corporate limits intersect with the City of Waterloo, then following the corporate limits of the City of Waterloo in a counter clockwise manner along the corporate limits of the City of Waterloo to the point of origin.

In accordance with Chapter 49.11 this precinct will include Townships Poyner, Precinct One and East Waterloo.

**TITLE I ADMINISTRATION
CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS**

1-6-3 L. is amended by adding the following to the description of Poyner Precinct Two: This precinct includes the City of Gilbertville.

Also amend by adding the following to the description of Fox Precinct: This precinct includes a portion of the City of Jesup.

**TITLE I ADMINISTRATION
CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS**

1-6-3 N. is amended by adding the following to the description of Washington Precinct: This precinct includes a portion of the City of Janesville.

**TITLE I ADMINISTRATION
CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS**

1-6-3 O. CEDAR FALLS WARD 1 PRECINCT 3/CEDAR FALLS PRECINCT 2 shall be deleted.

**TITLE I ADMINISTRATION
CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTON PRECINCTS**

1-6-3 P. WATERLOO WARD 3 PRECINCT 1/EAST WATERLOO PRECINCT 2 shall be deleted.

Summary

Ordinance No. 94 is an amendment to the Ordinance Establishing the Election Precincts in all Unincorporated Areas of Black Hawk County, Iowa now known as TITLE I ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 6 – ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS. Amendments represent the elimination of precincts Cedar Falls Township Precinct 2 and East Waterloo Township Precinct 2 required by the Secretary of State’s Office during the 2002 redistricting process which have now been eliminated.

CERTIFICATION

The Black Hawk County Auditor shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause it to be published.
